**TYEE FOUNDATION-** Pen #1 has been 85% repaired with the help of Mel & crew, with materials donated at cost from Golden State Lumber along with a grant from the Belvedere Community Foundation and expert help from many Tyee Club Members.

We will be receiving at least 25,000 fish from Fish and Game. Jared Huffman and the Director have promised we will have at least this many fish from DFG. I say at least because Bill Smith at the Mokolumne River Hatchery is working on securing 50,000 fish for us. These fish could possibly be tagged and marked fish. This will give us a hard number in 3 years to work from for our returning fish. The hatcheries are planting the least amount of salmon they have ever released. Our numbers should shine, because nobody has ever raised their fish to the size we do.

Additionally the Moseley Family that have developed the marina near us, has graciously started building us a pen to rear the added 25,000 fish. We will be asking the manufacturer to help us repair the other pen that was damaged in the storm. It appears that the cause of the pens breaking apart was a support beam that was never welded. the pieces were there but it was never welded. The break happened at that exact spot.

We have also secured the funding of a new floating pen from the Bay Delta Stamp Committee. They will build a pen for us, DFG will own it, and we will run it under a MOU agreement. We are currently trying to get three bids to start the process. We are very fortunate to have all of these options to help us rebuild stronger. We are being recognized as the experts in raising salmon, and we are helping solve the salmon crunch that is affecting all of us. CONGRATULATIONS!
